Dear Parent/Carer

The Great War 1914 - 1918, Battlefields Trip 14 - 17 June 2019

The History Department is proposing to take a Field Trip to visit some of the sites associated with The First World War, around Ypres and the Somme, which we will have been studying during Year 9. Indeed, your son will be coming to the end of a major topic on the Great War and we feel that he will be in a position to get a great deal from the trip.

We have made a provisional booking with Galloway, a company that we have travelled with before and have found to be the best in this field. Accommodation will be in a hostel in Kemmel, which is very modern, all rooms are en-suite, and to which we have also taken students previously. We will leave Sleaford at 6.30am on **Friday 14 June** and return at approximately 8pm on **Monday 17 June 2019**. The cost will be approximately £350 (based on a group of 40 – 47 students in the party) which will include all travel via the tunnel, three nights' accommodation, all meals, admission to all museums and sites, the group passport and full travel insurance. We have included a copy of the itinerary so that you can see what we will be seeing and doing during the four days.

Participation in this trip is clearly voluntary: places are conditional on staff expectations of extremely high standards of student behaviour. With this in mind, places will be allocated in consultation with the Head of Year 9 and will be dependent upon consistently high standards of behaviour demonstrated throughout the year. A mandatory code of conduct for all foreign visits now exists and is enclosed with this letter.

If you would like your son to take part in this trip, please complete the attached reply slip and code of conduct form and return it by **Friday 21 September.** The trip will then appear on your Parent Pay account. **The deposit of £60 will be payable by Friday 28 September,** which will enable us to confirm the booking with Galloway. The deposit will be returned should we not receive approval from the governors. There are only 47 places available, but we will keep a list of reserves if there are more students wanting a place. There is the possibility of a second coach if numbers are sufficient. If we do not have 40 boys wishing to go, your deposit will be returned, though we have always found these trips to be very popular in the past.

Once it has been confirmed the trip is running you will see it on your ParentPay account, which will allow you to pay the deposit. Once this deposit has been paid to Galloway it will be non-refundable. Further details will follow in due course.
