In 2016/17, 46% of children in our local schools took part in a sports event. We would like to see more young people involved during 2017/18 so have produced some guidance below. As you can see we have tiered the competitions in an attempt to provide an opportunity for all children of different abilities and ages to take part.

School Games Competition Programme: These events are for your best athletes and high ability children whilst also giving opportunities for SEN children to take part in competitive sport. These events are free to all schools. Please do not enter if you are not willing to progress to the county finals (subject to qualification). County finals might be on a weekend.

School Games Development Festivals: There is no progression to county finals. Again these events are free to all schools.

Outreach Competition Series: These events are another chance to use your best athletes in competition. There are medals for winners. Additional buy in is needed in order to enter these events. Some of these events will progress on to further rounds subject to county interest.

Outreach Development Sports: In these events we are encouraging schools to use different children to those taking part in the sports above. We would like to see a wide range of children entering the events. These are still competitive so some ability is required. Additional buy in is needed in order to enter these events.

Outreach Development KS2 Festivals: These festivals are aimed at children who have not taken part in any of the sports above. They give a chance for children to try new sports and there are no medals for winners. All children taking part receive a participation certificate. Additional buy in is needed in order to enter these events.

Outreach Development KS1 Festivals: Aimed at children who are in KS1. These sports give the opportunity for younger children to represent the school and experience competing against other schools. Participation certificates will be given to all children taking part. Additional buy in is needed in order to enter these events.

Outreach Change 4 Life: These events are for lower ability/SEN Children. These are run to encourage those who are not engaged in sport to try something new and become more active. Additional buy in is needed in order to enter all of these events however all schools are invited to attend 2 of these without buy-in.
