Duke of Edinburgh Year 9 Bronze

I am thrilled that your son has enrolled to do Bronze Duke of Edinburgh through the Robert Carre Trust. I have processed the application forms and registered him online and, as a result, he should have received an email to tell him his user name and password for the eDofE system.

I note that many of the boys have not come to see me yet to sign for their packs and compass. Furthermore, looking on the system only about half have logged in at all.

I encourage all participants to get online during the Christmas period to set up their section planners and send them to me for approval. (If I can see and approve planners before you embark on the section it will save any confusion at the end if this turns out to be unsuitable). Remember if you are already doing dancing or football for your physical, for example, then see if the system will let you backdate your start date to save you time. You also need to be gathering evidence of what you are doing as you go, uploading this to eDofE and sending it to me for approval. The new mobile site www.m.edofe.org may make adding evidence easier for you. The clock is ticking!

Although you are not participating in the expedition section of your Award this academic year I am still very interested in assisting you. Please come to see me to ask for help, share with me what you are doing or just chat about your Award.
