Year 9 students from the Robert Carre Trust are taking part in an interactive Modern Foreign Languages based Enterprise Challenge on **Friday 15 December** during the school day at Carre's. The aim of the day is to give students an opportunity to find out more about careers involving languages and business, and to develop their confidence in using their language skills.

During the day, students will complete a series of tasks in mixed teams relating to designing and marketing a product for an international fair, with the ultimate aim of pitching a bid in one of the foreign languages they study at school. They will also have the opportunity to work with native speakers and experience a language taster session as part of the day.

This is a free-of-charge event and all students in Year 9 will be participating.
