## **Instrumental Tuition**

Your son is now approaching the end of his trial instrumental lessons and I am now writing to ask if you wish for him to continue with lessons in September.

We are hoping to be able to keep students in groups of two, wherever possible, to reduce the cost implications. Group sizes inevitably depend on the uptake for these lessons.

The price per term for individual lessons is £226 (3 payments per year). If your son is in a group of 2 this would reduce the cost to £113. The school offers a remission scheme of 50% for any child who qualifies for Free School Meals.

The school's finance department will send out a bill for these payments at the beginning of each school term.

Please understand that learning an instrument requires commitment. We would expect students to continue with these lessons throughout the academic year; lessons should only be terminated in exceptional circumstances (please contact Mrs Quinton **in writing**).

I hope that your son has enjoyed the tuition that he has received during Year 7 and I hope that he is enthusiastic to continue with it in September. Please complete the form below as soon as possible so that I can make all the necessary arrangements.
