Dear Parent/Carer

The Ethics and Philosophy Departments at both Carre's and KSHS have been given the opportunity to take the students studying A Level Religious Studies (Ethics and Philosophy), to a national conference at the Wesleyan Methodist Church in Cambridge on **Friday 16 March 2018**. The aim of the conference is to explore key topics from the syllabus with Dr Peter Vardy. This conference will cover Christian Ethics: natural moral law, proportionalism, situation ethics and the concept of agape love, faith and reason and the teleological argument for the existence of God. The sessions are pacey, full of current examples, images and film clips, offering examination techniques and building broader subject knowledge. This year there is the opportunity to take part in a lively debate on whether murder could ever be justified.

We will be travelling by bus and will depart from Carre's Grammar School at **7.15am**. Please ensure your son/daughter arrives in plenty of time. We will leave Cambridge at approximately **3.30pm** and will, therefore, arrive back at school at approximately **5pm** depending on traffic conditions. Transport and entrance to the conference comes to **£28** and this includes extensive notes on the sessions, plus an essay writing and revision guide. Students will need to either bring a packed lunch or money to enable them to purchase lunch near the venue in Cambridge.

As these conferences are extremely popular there are a limited number of places available. I would, therefore, be grateful if you would let me know whether you wish your son/daughter to take part in the visit by completing the reply slip below and returning it to the main office at Carre's as soon as possible, though no later than **Monday 11 December 2017**. The trip will appear on your ParentPay account to enable payments to be made by **Monday 18 December 2017** as tickets have to be purchased early to obtain discounts.

We believe this will be an invaluable experience for our AS/A Level students studying Ethics and Philosophy.
