## Dear Parent/Carer

We are proposing to take the Year 12 Geography students on four Field Trips on **Tuesday 12 June, Thursday 14 June, Monday 18 June** and **Friday 22 June 2018.** The trips on 12 and 18 June will be to collect data from various locations on the Norfolk Coast and Yorkshire coast respectively. The trips on 14 and 22 June will be to collect data in several parts of Sheffield and Hull respectively. All trips will run from **8am until 6pm**. Students will be using some of this data within their Geographical Investigation worth 20% of their A Level grade; it is, therefore, essential that all students attend.

During the visits the students will spend the days working in small groups, collecting information to be processed within the classroom. They will need to bring either money to buy lunch or a packed lunch on the Sheffield and Hull trips and they will need a packed lunch on both the Coasts trips as there will be nowhere to buy food. All trips are non school uniform.

In order to cover transport, the combined cost of all the trips is £47. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988 we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
