The History Department is proposing to take Year 8 students to the Black Country Museum on Tuesday 19 June 2018. The aim of this trip is to enhance the students' understanding of the impact of the Industrial Revolution which they will be studying in terms 5 and 6.

Students will be leaving school at 9am but will be not be returning to school until approximately 7pm, dependent on traffic. This means that you will be responsible for arranging transport home for your child.

The cost of this trip will be £22. This covers both the cost of transport and entry to the museum. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988 we can only raise the cost of any visit by voluntary contributions. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.

Students must wear school uniform and we would suggest a waterproof as students will be outside for most of the day. A packed lunch will be required. Students entitled to Free School Meals should collect their meal from the Catering Manager prior to departure.

Students will be supervised at all times by a member of staff from Carre's and a guide will be provided by the Museum for each group.
