The Psychology Department has been given the opportunity to take the students studying AS/A Level Psychology to a Brain Awareness Event, 'Getting to Know Your Brain' organised by the Medical Department at Leicester University on **Wednesday 14 March 2018**. This will be an exciting afternoon of neuroscience for the students and will reinforce their studies in Biopsychology.

During the event there will be a couple of talks followed by interactive demonstrations including 'Tricking the brain in the neuroscience of illusion' and 'The developing eye using light to explore the retina'.

We will be travelling by coach and will depart from Carre's Grammar School at **11am**. We will leave Leicester at approximately **4.30pm** and will, therefore, arrive back at school at approximately **6pm** depending on traffic conditions.
