We are proposing to take a party from school on a skiing experience to Panorama in British Columbia, Canada. https://www.panoramaresort.com/

The school has organised many of these courses in the past, as we feel that an outdoor activity of this type, involving specific training in a new sport, is extremely worthwhile. This year we have selected Panorama, a resort in the Purcell Range of mountains. The Panorama ski resort is thought to be in the top 10 resorts in the world for skiing; the resort only allows access to 4 school groups at any one time ensuring the resort is not too busy. The resort offers the largest vertical drop in Canada of 4000ft with access to almost 3000 acres.
