Year 7 Visit to The Merchant of Venice - Tolethorpe Hall, Friday 29 June 2018

In their English lessons this term the Year 7 students are being introduced to the work of William Shakespeare. The Year 7s are being introduced to some of his key works, his language and the theatre experience of his time. In order to bring this Shakespeare introduction to life we would like to offer the students the opportunity to experience a live performance of one of his plays.
