## Big Bang Fair – NEC Birmingham – 15 March 2019

As part of British National Science week, the Robert Carre Trust is organising a joint trip between Kesteven and Sleaford High School and Carre's Grammar School to the *Big Bang Fair* for all Year 7 students. The *Big Bang Fair* engages and inspires young people through interactive and engaging activities, workshops and shows.

Parents are asked to make a voluntary contribution of £10.50 to cover the costs of the transport. No student will be excluded from the event because of an inability to make payment; however, without a sufficient level of voluntary contributions the event will not go ahead.
