I would like to inform you about our forthcoming Harvest Festival. As part of our charitable commitment to our local community, the school will be collecting food and produce to support the Community Larder in Sleaford. The Community Larder operates as our local food bank. We believe it is important that our students learn and understand the values of citizenship and supporting people less fortunate within our society. Therefore, between Tuesday 24 September and Monday 7 October 2019, we will be collecting food and produce to help local families feed themselves. The Community Larder has made the following suggestions for donation:

- Tins of hot dog sausages, meatballs, ravioli, meat, casseroles, curries and stews.
- Tins/jars of sauce – bolognaise, sweet and sour, chilli.
- Tinned vegetables and potatoes.
- Tinned fruit.
- Tinned milk puddings such as custard, rice pudding.
- Snack rice and noodles.
- UHT Milk.
- Boxes of cereal.
- Jars of jam or sandwich paste.
- Cuppa soups.
- Biscuits or Treats
- Toilet Rolls.
- Shower gel.
- Shampoo.
- Toothpaste.

This year, we are adding an element of *House Competition* to the collection. Each student should donate an item(s) in their house's colour. All items should be placed on the tables in the school foyer. The winning house will be announced in a whole school assembly on Monday 7 October:
