I have pleasure in offering your son the opportunity to join us on our July visit to the Côte d'Opale region, in North-Western France.

We plan to travel by coach on **Friday 10 July 2020** from Sleaford to the village of Stella Plage which is close to the town of Boulogne-sur-Mer. We shall return to Sleaford on the evening of **Sunday 12 July 2020**.

From our hotel, we hope to go on coach trips to various places of historical and cultural interest. These include visits to a traditional French sweet shop and to the World War II Museum 'La Coupole'. There will be plenty of activities to keep the boys occupied in the evenings, including an opportunity to sample some of the French regional delicacies.

This is a non-curriculum-based visit, which is only open to Year 7 and Year 8 boys who are studying French. Each day there will be language activities and, it is hoped, the boys will become more confident in their use of French. All boys will be expected to keep journals, in French, to record their experiences and teaching staff will, of course, be helping them with this. There will be prizes for the best ones.

The cost of the trip is £200, based on 40 participants. This cost will cover hotel accommodation on a full-board basis, entry to the various attractions and any contingencies that may arise. If necessary, places will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. Financial support may be available if you are eligible; please contact Mr Green, Director of Finance, Administration and Resources for more information.

If you would like your son to participate in this trip, please complete and return the reply slip below by **Wednesday 26 February**. If the trip becomes viable it will appear on your ParentPay account and the first non-refundable payment of £50 will be required by Wednesday 4 March. A second interim payment of £75 will be due by 2 April, with a final payment of £75 due 8 weeks before departure on 15 May. All students on the visit must have their **own** passport with a minimum validity of six months and a valid FHIC card.
