We are proposing to take Year 12 students on a residential Geography Field Trip on **Thursday 26 March to Friday 27 March 2020**. We will be going to Yorkshire to study coastal characteristics on the Holderness Coast and Urban Regeneration in Hull. We will be collecting data for the Geography coursework element of the A Level which is worth 20% of the grade awarded.

We will set off from Carre's at 8am on Thursday and return at approximately 5.30pm on Friday. We will be staying overnight at the Premier Inn in Bridlington and the students will receive their evening meal and breakfast. They will need to provide their own lunches on Thursday and Friday and there will be an opportunity to purchase food on those days. During the fieldwork the students will be spending time on a beach and so some old clothing would be advisable.

In order to cover transport, accommodation and food, the cost of the trip is £70. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988 we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
